
Replace Volvo Penta Hours LCD

The replacement LCD is a <u>Curtis Instruments module 701</u> available from <u>Farnell</u>, cost about £20. Note that this replaces the entire hour meter function, your previous meter is no longer available.


Dis-assemble tacho (1,2,3) The needle just pulls off take care not to bend it:



The old LCD display can be prised out with a blade under the edge - the ribbon cable 'can' be pulled out but it is better to try and lever up the sides of the white terminal block to release (5,6,7):




This is the back of the new LCD (8):



You then need to alter the cut-out to fit the new LC (9) I used a small saw blade and some files. The LCD fitted into place (10) I used silicone to fix it.

Wires soldered onto the terminals at the back (11) - these are powered by the ignition circuit



The parts of the tachometer separated to solder on the wires to the input terminals (12) on the back of the circuit board then re-assembled (13) Finished meter (14)
